**PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE
12TH SEPTEMBER 2011**

In line with the approved formular for the computation of prices of petroleum products, EWURA hereby publishes bi-weekly cap prices for petroleum products in the Tanzania Mainland local market. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Monday 12th September 2011**. These prices have been calculated in accordance with the new pricing formular which became effective in August 2011. Kindly take note of the following.

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices for all petroleum products, in the Tanzania Mainland local market have decreased compared to the prices which were prepared to be applicable effective 29th August 2011. Retail prices for various products have decreased as follows: Petrol by TZS 38.03 (or 1.84%), Diesel by TZS 45.15 (or 2.26%) and Kerosene by TZS 46.15 (or 2.33%). The price decreases have been caused by a fall in the petroleum products prices in the world market as follows: Petrol 2.54%, Diesel 3.78% and Kerosene 3.50%. Local market prices would have decreased more had it not been for the depreciation of the Tanzanian Shilling compared to the US dollar (the currency in which purchases of products in the international oil market are made), the shilling has depreciated by 0.20% compared to the last pricing cycle. The wholesale prices for the same period have consequently decreased as follows: Petrol by TZS 38.03 (or 1.90%), Diesel by TZS 45.15(or 2.34%) and Kerosene by TZS 46.15(or 2.41%).
- (b) Both retail and wholesale prices would have risen higher had there been no review of the petroleum pricing formula. A comparison of prices computations using the old formula and the new formular with regard to retail prices is as follows:

As it can be seen from the above table, the prices under the revised pricing formula are lower than they would have been if no review had been done.

- (c) In line with the prevailing sector legislation, prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of supply and demand. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by

making available petroleum products pricing information including price cap. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders to make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.

- (d) Oil marketing companies are free to sell their products at a price that give them competitive advantage, provided that such **price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product. The approved formula was gazetted through Government Notice No. 5 of 9th January 2009 and amendments made through Government Notice No. 216 of 29th July 2011.**
- (e) All petrol stations should publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should be clearly visible and should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are advised to purchase from those that sell products at the most competitive prices. **It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations and it will attract punitive measures from EWURA.**
- (f) Retailers must issue receipts with respect to all sales that they make and consumers are advised to **demand and keep receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of fuel and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold are off the approved specifications.
