**Call for Expressions of Interest**

1. This invitation for expressions of interest follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) which appeared in the Guardian Issue no. 4573 dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2009.
2. The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) has set aside funds for its operations during the financial year 2009/2010. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the funds will be used to cover eligible payments under the contract for provision of consultancy services for establishment of National Petroleum Information System (NPIS).
3. EWURA now invites eligible firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. The services will include but not limited to:
  - a) provide a consistent, user - friendly tool that allow EWURA Staff to retrieve data and information from downstream petroleum operators in mainland Tanzania;
  - b) provide a consistent, user - friendly tool that is consistent across regulated industries (recognizing that there are sector - specific idiosyncrasies) that allow EWURA Staff to view performance indicators for individual OMCs;
  - c) make compilation and processing of data more efficient;

- d) make storage of data safer and access to older data easier.
4. Interested firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services by submitting consultant's profile, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.
  5. For each assignment performed, the consultant shall provide the name and address of the client, date(s) of execution, value and financing sources. Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. Duly signed Memorandum of understanding should be attached in the EOI as a proof of such association.
  6. A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Public Procurement Act No. 21 of 2004 and the Public Procurement (Selection and Employment of Consultants) Regulations - Government Notice No. 98 of 2005.
  7. Selection will be conducted through the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) procedures specified in the Public Procurement Regulations.
  8. Interested eligible consultants may obtain further information from the office of the Secretary, EWURA Tender Board, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Room No. 516, Harbour View Towers, Samora Avenue/Mission Street from 8.00 A.M to 4.00 P.M on Mondays to Fridays inclusive except on public holidays.

  10. Late Expressions of Interest shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstances.
