

PUBLIC NOTICE

On 08th June, 2017 the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) received a Licence Application from Mikumi Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (MIKUMI WSSA). The license application is for operation of water supply and sanitation services in Mikumi Township.

Mikumi Water Supply and Sanitation Authority was established by the Government Notice number 29, published on 30th January, 2004, charged with the overall responsibility of provision of water supply and sanitation services to the population of Mikumi Township. Mikumi WSSA is located at Mikumi Township, Kilosa District, in Morogoro Region, and is classified as Category C water supply and sanitation authority.

The following are the particulars of Mikumi Water Supply and Sanitation Authority;

1.0 Name and address:

2.0 Type of License Applied:

Mikumi Water Supply and Sanitation Authority, (MIKUMI WSSA), applied for a license to provide Water Supply and Sanitation Services within Mikumi township, which is a township in Kilosa District, Morogoro Region. The area of which Mikumi Water Supply and Sanitation Authority will operate is Mikumi township.

3.0 Water Supply and Sanitation Infrastructure:

The applicant (MIKUMI WSSA) will operate by abstracting water from Madibila Spring Source, with capacity to supply $720m^3/day$. The applicant infrastructures include two concrete block storage tanks, with combined storage capacity of $360m^3$. Further, the applicant has a water supply network of $26km$ of different pipe types, classes and diameters. The applicant does not have water treatment facility, furthermore, the applicant; neither has waste water collection nor disposal facilities.

4.0 Ownership Structure:

Mikumi Water Supply and Sanitation Authority is 100% owned by the Government of the United Republic of Tanzania.

In accordance with Section 19(2) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, EWURA hereby initiates a public inquiry process to seek views on the reasonableness of the License Application.

Any person who wishes to make any presentation or objection with respect to the application should do so in writing to EWURA at the hereunder mentioned address not later than 17:00 hours on the 31st day of July, ,2017.
