A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM THE MAGANZO WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY ("MAGANZO WSSA") FOR YEAR 2017/18 – 2019/20

Tariff Application No. TR -W-17-006

On 15th August 2017, EWURA received the first Tariff Application from Maganzo Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Maganzo WSSA) for kiosk customers, prospective metered tariff for all customers, as well as other charges for the period of 2017/18 – 2019/20. Tables 1 to 5 below present detailed schedules of the proposed tariffs and charges.

This is the first time for Maganzo WSSA to apply for tariff review. The submission of the proposed tariff and charges to EWURA is according to section 28(d) of the Water Supply and Sanitation Act of 2009 and section 7 (1)(b)(iv) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414. Pursuant to Section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **Friday, 15th September 2017 at Maganzo BM Conference Hall** in Maganzo Town from **10:00hrs** to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC) and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

The deadline for registration of intent to intervene is on 6th September 2017. Those who wish to submit written comments on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and charges are invited to do so by writing to the Acting Director General using the above mentioned address by **15th September 2017**.
