A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM THE MANYONI WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY ("MANYONI WSSA") FOR YEAR 2017/18 – 2019/20

Tariff Application No. TR--W-17-10

On 20th June 2017 the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) received a Tariff Application from Manyoni Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Manyoni WSSA) requesting for a multiyear tariff adjustment for water services. Tables 1 to 6 below present detailed schedules of the current and proposed tariffs and charges.

According to Manyoni WSSA's submission, the proposed increase will enable them to raise sufficient revenue to finance operational and maintenance costs of water supply services, extension of water supply networks to new developed areas and capital investment and depreciation.

Pursuant to Sub-section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **Friday, 20th October 2017 at Maktaba Hall, Manyoni town** from **10:00hrs** to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC) and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Those who wish to submit written comments on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and charges are invited to do so by writing to the Director General using the above mentioned address at any time before **27th October 2017**.
