### A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM THE LINDI WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY ("LUWASA") FOR YEAR 2017/18 - 2019/20

#### Application for Tariff review Na. TR-W-17-012

On 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) received a Tariff Application from Lindi Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (LUWASA) for an increase in Tariff and charges for water supply services.
