## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM SINGIDA WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY ("Singida WSSA") FOR YEAR 2018/19 – 2020/21

Tariff Application No. TR-W-18-001

On 29th March 2018 the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) received a Tariff Application from Singida Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Singida WSSA) requesting for a multiyear tariff adjustment for water services. According to Singida WSSA, the proposed increase will enable them to pay for expenses which it incurs for operational and maintenance of water supply network, extension of service coverage to new developed areas and capital investment and depreciation.

Pursuant to sub-section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **Thursday**, 28<sup>th</sup> **June 2018 at Mlade Hall**, **FDC** from 10:00hrs to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC) and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Those who wish to submit written comments on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and charges are invited to do so by writing to the Director General using the above mentioned address at any time before 6<sup>th</sup> July 2018.
