

LOCAL SUPPLIERS AND SERVICE PROVIDERS DATABASE FOR 2018

1. Pursuant to Regulation 38(1) of the Petroleum (Local Content) Regulations, 2017, the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority “the Authority” informs the petroleum industry operators, suppliers, service providers and the general public that the Local Suppliers and Service Providers Database for the year 2018 “LSSP2018” with one hundred seventy (172) local business entities has been approved by the Authority. The approved list will be eligible to participate in the provision of various goods and services in the petroleum midstream and downstream activities in Mainland Tanzania for the year 2018. The list is accessible on the website of the Authority – www.ewura.go.tz.
2. In complying with the requirement of Regulation 38(1) of the Petroleum (Local Content) Regulations 2017 “hereinafter referred to as the Regulations”, the Authority launched the registration of local suppliers and service providers from 29th January, 2018 to 31st March, 2018. Over the two-month- period of registration, a total of one hundred eighty two (182) business entities applied for the registration into LSSP2018. Out of which, ten (10) business entities supplied inadequate information required by the Authority for registration.
3. During the registration exercise, the Authority informed each applicant of the status of completeness of the documentations required for registration. For those who had submitted incomplete information to the Authority were informed on the specific documents or information which were missing and urged each of them to avail the missing information in order to support their eligibility for registration.
4. All applicants, who did not qualify for registration into LSSP2018, and those failed to avail the requested documentation, are urged to resolve the outstanding documentation and resubmit their fresh application not later than 30th June, 2018.
5. The LSSP is an important tool for facilitating national participation in the country’s oil and gas sector in respect of midstream and downstream by enhancing the visibility of Tanzanian enterprises with the potential of offering a wide spectrum of goods and services in the oil and gas sector in Mainland Tanzania.
6. While it is a legal requirement for petroleum industry operators to procure various goods and services through the LSSP, it is worth noting, however, that the registration does not automatically guarantee an outright award of tenders. For purposes of promoting competition and efficiency, yet, competitive bidding amongst business entities that are under the same category in the LSSP will not be compromised.
