PUBLIC NOTICE

A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM MPWAPWA URBAN WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY ("Mpwapwa WSSA") FOR YEAR 2018/19 – 2020/21

Tariff Application No. TR-W-18-016

On 3rd July 2018 the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) received a Tariff Application from Mpwapwa urban Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Mpwapwa WSSA) requesting for a multiyear tariff adjustment for water services. According to Mpwapwa WSSA, the proposed increase will enable it to cater for high operational and maintenance costs, to meet rehabilitation and replacement costs and increase service coverage areas.

Pursuant to sub-section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **Thursday, 13th September 2018 at Maendeleo Hall, Mpwapwa Town** from **10:00hrs** to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC) and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Those who wish to submit written comments on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and charges are invited to do so by writing to the Director General using the above mentioned address by **18th September 2018**.
