PUBLIC NOTICE

A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM SHINYANGA WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (SHINYANGA WSSA) FOR YEAR 2018/19 – 2020/21

Tariff Application No. TR-W-18-002

On 9th April 2018, EWURA received complete Tariff Application from Shinyanga Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Shinyanga WSSA) requesting for a multi - year tariff adjustment (2018/19 – 2020/21) for water supply services. Tables 1 to 4 below show current and proposed tariffs and charges.

According to Shinyanga WSSA, proposed tariff will enable them to attain sound financial capability that will enable the authority to meet all costs including production, distribution and bulk water purchase costs. Further, Shinyanga WSSA explained that the proposed tariff will enable them to expand water distribution network, provide customers with sustainable service for 24 hours and satisfy customers' expectations.

Pursuant to Section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **Thursday, 13th September 2018 at CCM Shinyanga District Hall** in Shinyanga Municipality from **10:00hrs**. The main objective of the meeting is to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC), Shinyanga WSSA's customers and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Those who wish to submit written comments on the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs are invited to do so by writing to the Director General using the above mentioned address by **14th September 2018**.
