According to Arusha WSSA, the major reasons for requesting tariff review are: general rise in input prices in the market, counterpart contribution for existing and new asset investment financed by Africa Development Bank (AfDB), increase in staffing requirement because of the extended services coverage and establishment of five zone offices, and requirement to improve employees remuneration to attract and retain skilled and professional workforce.

Pursuant to Section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> September 2018 at Uwanja wa Makumbo Azimio la Arusha** in Arusha City from **10:00hrs**. The main objective of the meeting is to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC), K customers and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.
