PUBLIC NOTICE

A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM MISUNGWI WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (“MISUNGWI WSSA”) FOR YEAR 2018/19 – 2019/20

Tariff Application No. TR-W-18-007

On 26th July 2018 the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) received a Tariff Application from Misungwi Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Misungwi WSSA) requesting for multi - year tariff adjustment (2018/19 – 2020/21) for water services. According to Misungwi WSSA, the proposed increase will enable it to recover operational costs especially cost of electricity, maintenance of infrastructures to minimize leakages and to cover costs of general administrations.

Pursuant to sub-section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **21th September 2018 at Community Development Technical Training Institute** in Misungwi town from **10:00hrs** to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC) and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Those who wish to submit written comments on the legitimacy of the proposed tariff and charges are invited to do so by writing to the Director General using the above mentioned address at any time before **26th September, 2018**.
