A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM KONDOA WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (KONDOA WSSA) FOR YEARS 2018/19 – 2020/21

Tariff Application No. TR-W-18-015-2018/2019

On 9th November 2018, EWURA received complete Tariff Application from Kondo Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Kondo WSSA) requesting for a multi - year tariff adjustment (2018/19 – 2020/21) for water supply services. Tables 1 to 5 below show current and proposed tariffs and charges.

According to Kondoa WSSA, the main justification for tariff review application is the fact that current tariff and charges do not generate enough revenue to meet costs of operation and maintenance. Kondoa WSSA explained that proposed tariff and charges will enable the utility to cover the increased operational and maintenance costs, to improve water supply services and ensure better services to their customers.

Pursuant to Section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **Wednesday, 30th January 2019 at CCM Hall** in Kondoa from **10:00 hrs**. The main objective of the meeting is to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC), Kondoa WSSA's customers and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Those who wish to submit written comments on the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs are invited to do so by writing to the Director General using the above mentioned address at any time by **6th February 2019**.
