**PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE SATURDAY, THE 1<sup>st</sup> JULY, 2017**

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes Cap Prices for petroleum products, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Saturday, the 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2017**. Hereinafter, kindly, take note of the following:

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices for all petroleum products have decreased compared to prices that were published on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2017. For the month of July 2017, retail prices of Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene have decreased by TZS 37/litre (equivalent to 1.81%), TZS 14/litre (equivalent to 0.73%) and TZS 19/litre (equivalent to 1.03%) respectively. Similarly, compared to the last month publications, wholesale prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene have also decreased by TZS 37.21/litre (equivalent to 1.92%), TZS 13.70/litre (equivalent to 0.77%) and TZS 18.85/litre (equivalent to 1.10%) respectively. In spite of an increase of Excise Duty for petroleum products of TZS 40/litre with effect from July 2017, local pump prices have decreased. The decrease is largely attributed to a fall in world oil market prices and BPS premiums.
- (b) Retail and wholesale prices of Petrol and Diesel for Tanga Region have increased compared to prices that were published on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2017. Retail prices for Petrol and Diesel have increased by TZS 43/litre (equivalent to 2.19%) and TZS 4/litre (equivalent to 0.21%), respectively. Likewise, wholesale prices for Petrol and Diesel have increased by TZS 43.07/litre (equivalent to 2.33%) and TZS 3.81/litre (equivalent to 0.22%), respectively. The increases in local pump prices in Tanga are attributed to the increase in world oil market prices of the new consignment received through Tanga port compared to the prices of the last consignment that was received in April 2017. As a result of not having new consignment of Kerosene received through Tanga port in the month of June 2017, Petrol Station Operators in Tanga are advised to source the product from Dar es Salaam and therefore, the price of Kerosene for Tanga region will be based on the cost of the product received through Dar es Salaam port and bridging cost to Tanga.
- (c) It should be noted that in the month of June 2017, Tanzania Parliament passed the Finance Bill 2017, which among other things, stipulates the required changes in the Excise Duty charged on petroleum products i.e petrol, diesel and kerosene where Tshs.40 has been increased for each one litre of petrol, diesel and kerosene over and above the prevailing Excise Duty rates on these products. Furthermore, the Finance Bill 2017 indicates that this new increment should be implemented effective 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017. Because of these new changes, EWURA has included this new charge increment in the July 2017 prices of petrol, diesel and kerosene.

- (d) The Authority would like to remind the public that these cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialling **\*152\*00#** and then following the provided instructions. This service is free of charge and is available in all mobile phone service providers in the country.
- (e) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (**Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166**), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including cap prices. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (f) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that gives them a competitive advantage provided that, such **price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as was computed using the approved formula, which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 216 published in May 2017.**
- (g) All petrol stations are required to publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should be clearly visible and should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are encouraged to purchase from stations that sell products at the most competitive prices and offer better services. **It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations and it will attract punitive measures from EWURA.**
- (h) Retailers must issue receipts with respect to all sales that they make and consumers are required to **demand and keep receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of petroleum product (fuel) and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold do not meet the approved specifications.
