PUBLIC NOTICE

A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON AN APPLICATION FOR MULTI-YEAR WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION TARIFFS SUBMITTED BY KASULU WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (KASULU WSSA)

On 12th March 2026, EWURA received an application from Kasulu Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Kasulu WSSA) requesting approval of multi-year water supply tariffs and fees. After confirming that the application met the required criteria, EWURA accepted it for review on 16th June 2026. Table 1, Table 2 and Table 3 present the tariffs and fees proposed by Kasulu WSSA for FYs 2026/27 to 2030/31.

Kasulu WSSA stated that the proposed tariff adjustment is necessary to cope with increasing operation and maintenance costs and to finance the rehabilitation and replacement of aging water supply and sanitation infrastructure.

This public notice is made pursuant to Section 19(4) of the EWURA Act, Cap. 414, which requires the Authority to issue a notice of inquiry to collect views from stakeholders on the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs and and fees.

As part of the inquiry process, EWURA will conduct a public hearing meeting on **23rd July 2026** in **Kasulu town**. The meeting will commence at 10.00 a.m. at **Kasulu Town Council Hall**.
