PUBLIC NOTICE

A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON AN APPLICATION FOR MULTI-YEAR WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION TARIFFS SUBMITTED BY MAKAMBAKO WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (MAKAMBAKO WSSA)

On 4th June 2026, EWURA received an application from Makambako Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Makambako WSSA) requesting approval of multi-year water supply and sanitation tariffs for the financial years 2026/27 to 2030/31. The application was accepted for processing on 8th July 2026. Tables 1 to 3 present the tariffs and fees proposed by Makambako WSSA.

Makambako WSSA has submitted a Multi-Year Business Plan aimed at improving water supply and sanitation services within its service area. The proposed tariffs are intended to enable the Authority to meet increasing operation and maintenance costs, expand service coverage, connect additional customers, maintain service quality, and increase access to safe and clean water to more than 97% of the population by 2031.

This public notice is made pursuant to Section 19(4) of the EWURA Act, Cap. 414, which requires the Authority to issue a notice of inquiry to collect views from stakeholders on the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs, charges and fees.

As part of the inquiry process, EWURA will conduct a public hearing meeting on 13th August 2026 in Makambako Town. The meeting will commence at 10.00 a.m. at Star Right Hall, Makambako.
