PUBLIC NOTICE

A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON AN APPLICATION FOR PROVISIONAL WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION TARIFFS SUBMITTED BY KYELA-KASUMULU WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (KYELA-KASUMULU WSSA)

On 5 August 2026, EWURA received an application from Kyela-Kasumulu Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Kyela-Kasumulu WSSA) for provisional water supply tariffs and fees. After checking its completeness, EWURA accepted the application for detailed review on 11 August 2026. Tables 1 to 3 present the current tariffs and fees and those proposed by Kyela-Kasumulu WSSA for the financial years 2026/27 and 2027/28.

Kyela-Kasumulu Water Supply and Sanitation Authority stated that it is seeking provisional tariffs to cover operating and maintenance costs, rehabilitate infrastructure and sustain service delivery while preparing its five-year Business Plan. The Authority also stated that

damage to its offices resulted in the loss of important documents and equipment needed to prepare the plan.

This public notice is made pursuant to Section 19(4) of the EWURA Act, Cap. 414, which requires the Authority to issue a notice of inquiry to collect views from stakeholders on the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs and fees.

As part of the inquiry process, EWURA will hold a public hearing on **8 October 2026** at the **Kyela District Council Hall** in Kyela.
