**PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE
WEDNESDAY, 1st June 2016**

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes cap petroleum products prices, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday 1st June 2016**. Furthermore, please take note of the following:

- (a) Both retail and wholesale petroleum products prices in Tanzania Mainland have increased as compared with prices in the publication of 4th May 2016. Retail prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene have increased by TZS 80/Litre or 4.49%, TZS 31/Litre or 1.95% and TZS 29/Litre or 1.84%, respectively. Also, wholesale prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene have increased by TZS 80.12/Litre or 4.78%, TZS 31.20/Litre or 2.09% and TZS 29.10/Litre or 1.98% respectively. To a large extent, increases in wholesale and retail local petroleum products prices have been caused by continued increase of petroleum products prices in the world market.
- (b) The Authority would like to inform the public that, these cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialling ***152*00#** and follow the instructions. This service is free of charge and available in all mobile phone service providers in the country.
- (c) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including price cap. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders to make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (d) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that gives them a competitive advantage provided that, such **price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as was computed using the approved formula, which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 405/2015 of July 2015.**
- (e) All petrol stations should publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should be clearly visible and should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are advised to purchase from those stations that sell products at the most competitive prices. **It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations and it will attract punitive measures from EWURA.**
- (f) Retailers must issue receipts with respect to all sales that they make and consumers are advised to **demand and keep receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such

purchase was made as well as, the type of fuel and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold are off the approved specifications.
