PRELIMINARIES

EWURA has noted with concern that you have constructed a petrol station without applying and obtaining a construction approval from the Authority contrary to section 127 (1) of the Petroleum Act, Cap.392 and Rule 4 of the Petroleum (Retail Operations) Rules, GN.No.168 of 2015, which require any person intending to construct a petroleum installation facility to obtain a construction approval before construction of the same. Constructing a petroleum installation facility without obtaining a construction approval from EWURA contravenes the law and is punishable as such.

ORDER

Therefore, and based on the foregoing EWURA has considered the matter in accordance with the applicable law and has decided that **Lambo Petrol Station** located at **Machame Area, Moshi Municipality** in **Kilimanjaro Region** be and is **HEREBY ORDERED** to:

- (a) immediately stop undertaking petroleum operations at your facility located at **Lambo Petrol Station** located at **Machame Area, Moshi Municipality** in **Kilimanjaro Region**; and
- (b) explain in writing within seven (7) days from the date of receipt of this Order why severe punishment should not be taken against you for undertaking construction of a retail outlet without obtaining a construction approval from EWURA.
