PUBLIC NOTICE

A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM NANSIO URBAN WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (“NANSIO WSSA”) FOR YEAR 2019/20 – 2021/22

Tariff Application No. TR-W-18-049

On 2nd May 2019 the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) received a Tariff Application from Nansio Urban Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Nansio WSSA) requesting for a multiyear tariff adjustment for water services. Table 1 below presents detailed schedule of the current and proposed tariffs

According to Nansio WSSA, the main justification for tariff review application is to generate enough revenue to meet the increased operational and maintenance costs. Nansio WSSA explained that proposed tariffs will enable them to cover the increased

operational and maintenance costs, expand water network, and undertake water-related investments to assure better services to their customers.

Pursuant to sub-section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on **Wednesday, 26th June 2019 at Ukerewe District Council Hall from 10:00hrs** to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC) and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Those who wish to submit written comments on the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs and charges are invited to do so by writing to the Director General using the above mentioned address by **2nd July 2019 before 4.00PM**.
