PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY, 2nd March 2016

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes cap petroleum products prices, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday 2nd March 2016**. Furthermore, please take note of the following:

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices for all petroleum products imported through Dar es Salaam port have changed compared with prices that were applicable in February 2016. For March 2016, retail prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene have decreased by TZS 31/litre or 1.70%, TZS 114/litre or 7.10% and TZS 234/Litre or 13.75%. Similarly, compared with the last month publication, wholesale prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene have decreased by TZS 34.41 /litre or 1.98%, TZS 116.63/litre or 7.80% and TZS 236.65 /litre or 14.85% respectively. These continued drop of the local market prices have been caused by fall of prices of petroleum products in the world market.
- (b) There was no new consignment of Petrol and Diesel that were received through TANGA port during February 2016, as such TANGA prices that were published in February 2016 shall continue to apply.
- (c) The Authority would like to inform the public that, these cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialling *152*00# and follow the instructions. These service is free of charge and available in all mobile phone service providers in the country.
- (d) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including price cap. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders to make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (e) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that give them a competitive advantage provided that, such price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as was computed using the approved formula, which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 405/2015 of July 2015.
- (f) All petrol stations should publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should be clearly visible and should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are advised to purchase from those stations that sell products at the most competitive prices. It is an offence not to have

- prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations and it will attract punitive measures from EWURA.
- (g) Retailers must issue receipts with respect to all sales that they make and consumers are advised to **demand and keep receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of fuel and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold are off the approved specifications.
