PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY, 03rd FEBRUARY 2016

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes cap petroleum products prices, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday 3rd February2016**. Furthermore, please take note of the following:

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices for Diesel and Petrol have changed compared to prices that were published on 6th January 2016. Retail prices for Petrol and Diesel have decreased by TZS 55/litre or 2.91% and by TZS 147/litre or 8.40%, respectively, there is no change on the retail price of Kerosene. Similarly, compared to the last month publication, wholesale prices for Petrol and Diesel have decreased by TZS 55.27/litre or 3.08% and by TZS 146.78/litre or 8.94%. There is no change on the wholesale price for Kerosene. To a large extent, these continued drop of petroleum products prices in the local market are being caused by decrease of prices of petroleum products in the world market as well as the decrease in freight and premium charges. There were no fresh imports of Kerosene during the month of January 2016, as such prices for this product remain as were in January 2016.
- (b) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including price cap. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders to make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (c) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that give them a competitive advantage provided that, such price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as was computed by the approved formula which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 405/2015 of July 2015.
- (d) All petrol stations should publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should be clearly visible and should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are advised to purchase from those stations that sell products at the most competitive prices. It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations and it will attract punitive measures from EWURA.
- (e) Retailers must issue receipts with respect to all sales that they make and consumers are advised to **demand and keep receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such purchase was made as well as the type of fuel and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is

above the cap price or in case the products sold are off the approved specifications.
