PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE
WEDNESDAY, 4th JULY 2018

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes Cap Prices for petroleum products, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday, 4th July 2018**. Hereinafter, kindly, take note of the following:

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices for Petrol and Diesel imported in the country through Dar es Salaam port have changed compared to prices that were published on 6th June 2018, while retail and wholesale prices for Kerosene remain unchanged as there was no new consignment of Kerosene imported through Dar es Salaam port in the month of June 2018. For the month of July 2018, retail prices of Petrol and Diesel have increased by TZS 126/litre (equivalent to 5.53%) and TZS 166/litre (equivalent to 7.66%), respectively. Similarly, compared to the publication of last month, wholesale prices of Petrol and Diesel have also increased by TZS 125.82/litre (equivalent to 5.83%) and TZS 165.19/litre (equivalent to 8.10%), respectively. The increase in local prices of petroleum products is largely attributed to continued increase in the world oil market prices.
- (b) There was no new consignment of petroleum products imported through Tanga port in the month of June 2018. Hence, in July 2018, the prices of petroleum products sold in the Northern regions remain the same as were in June 2018. Moreover, due to the depletion of kerosene in Tanga region, Petrol Station Operators in the Northern regions are advised to source the product from Dar es Salaam and therefore, the retail price of Kerosene for the Northern regions will be based on the cost of the product received through Dar es Salaam port and bridging cost to Northern regions.
- (c) It should be noted that, the cost of most of the consignments of petroleum products received through the Dar es Salaam port in the month of June 2018 were based on the world oil market prices of May 2018, while the consignments received in the preceding month were based on the world oil market prices of March 2018. The increases in July 2018 local prices are therefore due to the consecutive increases in world oil market prices in April 2018 and May 2018.
- (d) Following the Government's decision in May 2018 to use Mtwara port to receive petroleum products through the Bulk Procurement System (BPS) as a way of improving efficiency of petroleum products supply in the Southern regions (Mtwara, Lindi and Ruvuma), the public is hereby informed that, based on the limited imported quantity of products, on 3rd July 2018, Mtwara port received the first ever BPS consignment of petroleum products (Petrol and Diesel) for Mtwara consumption. However, since the quantity received for the time being suffices the demand of Mtwara region only, in this regard, Mtwara prices for Diesel and Petrol are based on the actual cost of Petrol and Diesel received through Mtwara port and the bridging cost to various Mtwara districts while prices for kerosene will continue to be based on Dar es Salaam port. Therefore, Petrol Station Operators in the Mtwara region are advised to source the product from Dar es Salaam. For the month of July 2018, retail prices of Petrol and Diesel in Mtwara have

increased by TZS 32/litre (equivalent to 1.35%) and TZS 124/litre (equivalent to 5.53%), respectively.

- (e) It should be further noted that, computation and publication of petroleum products prices ex- Mtwara port receipt for other Southern regions (Lindi and Ruvuma) will be implemented whenever enough petroleum products (petrol, diesel and kerosene) are imported through Mtwara port to suffice the demand for the regions.
- (f) The Authority would like to remind the public that these cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialling ***152*00#** and then following the provided instructions. This service is free of charge and is available in all mobile phone service providers in the country.
- (g) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (**Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166**), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including cap prices. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (h) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that gives them a competitive advantage provided that, such **price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as was computed using the approved formula, which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 269 published in June 2018.**
- (i) All petrol stations are required to publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are encouraged to purchase from stations that sell products at the most competitive prices and offer better services. **It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations. Failure to adhere to this directive will attract punitive measures from EWURA.**
- (j) Retailers must issue receipts printed from an Electronic Fiscal Pump Printer (EFPP) with respect to all sales that they make and consumers are required to **demand and keep those receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of petroleum product (fuel) and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold do not meet the approved specifications and also, provide an assurance that appropriate government taxes on petroleum products purchased are fully accounted for recovery from the Retailers.
