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PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY, 6th NOVEMBER 2019

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes Cap Prices for petroleum products, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday**, 6th **November 2019**. Hereinafter, kindly take note of the following:

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene imported in the country through **Dar es Salaam port** have increased compared to prices that were published on 2nd October 2019. For the month of November 2019, retail prices of Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene increased by TZS 98/litre (equivalent to 4.67%), TZS 49/litre (equivalent to 2.31%) and TZS 62/litre (equivalent to 3.00%), respectively. Similarly, compared to the publication of last month, wholesale prices of Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene increased by TZS 97.48/litre (equivalent to 4.95%) and TZS 48.67/litre (equivalent to 2.45%) and TZS 61.51/litre (equivalent to 3.18%), respectively.
- (b) Retail and wholesale prices for Petrol and Diesel in Tanga region have decreased compared to prices that were published on 2nd October 2019. For the month of November 2019, retail prices of Petrol and Diesel **in the Northern regions** (i.e Tanga, Arusha, Kilimanjaro and Manyara) have decreased by TZS 104/litre (equivalent to 4.51%) and TZS 16/litre (equivalent to 0.73%), respectively. Likewise, wholesale prices of Petrol and Diesel have also decreased by TZS 103.30/litre (equivalent to 4.75%) and TZS 16.04/litre (equivalent to 0.77%), respectively. *Kerosene prices in the Northern regions shall remain to be as published on 2nd October 2019 because there was no new consignment of Kerosene received through Tanga port in the month of October 2019*.
- (c) Similarly, retail and wholesale prices for Petrol and Diesel in Mtwara region have changed compared to prices that were published on 2nd October 2019. For the month of November 2019, retail prices of Petrol in the Southern regions (i.e Mtwara, Lindi and Ruvuma) have decreased by TZS 88/litre (equivalent to 3.80%) while prices of Diesel have increased by TZS 1/litre (equivalent to 0.05%). Likewise, wholesale prices of Petrol have also decreased by TZS 87.72/litre (equivalent to 4.00%) while prices of Diesel have increased by TZS 1.00/litre (equivalent to 0.05%). Furthermore, since there is no Kerosene at Mtwara storage terminals, Petrol Station Operators in Mtwara, Lindi and Ruvuma regions are advised to source the product from Dar es Salaam and therefore, the retail prices of Kerosene for those regions is based on the cost of the product received through Dar es Salaam port and bridging cost to the regions.
- (d) The increase in local prices of petroleum products imported through Dar es Salaam port is mainly attributable to an increase in BPS premiums and the world oil market prices as shown in **Table C**. On the other hand, As shown in **Table C** and **Table D**, changes in prices of petroleum products received through Tanga and Mtwara ports are mainly attributed to the decrease in BPS premiums and a decrease in world oil market prices of

September 2019 when compared to those of July 2019 which were applicable since the last consignment was received through Tanga and Mtwara ports. It should be noted that, before this publication of petroleum prices for the month of November 2019, the last petroleum consignment at Tanga and Mtwara ports was received in August 2019 where its cost was based on the world oil market prices of July 2019 while the last consignment at Dar es Salaam port was received in September 2019 where its cost was based on the world oil market prices of August 2019. The difference in months of importation of petroleum products between the three ports is thus the reason for differences in the movement of petroleum prices between the ports.

- (e) EWURA would like to remind the public that these cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialling *152*00# and then following the provided instructions. This service is free of charge and is available in all mobile phone service providers in the country.
- (f) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (**Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166**), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including cap prices. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (g) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that gives them a competitive advantage provided that, such price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as it is computed using the approved formula, which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 163 published in April 2018 and Government Notice No. 269 published in June 2018.
- (h) All petrol stations are required to publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are encouraged to purchase from stations that sell products at the most competitive prices and offer better services. It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations. Failure to adhere to this directive will attract punitive measures from EWURA.
- (i) Retailers must issue receipts printed from an Electronic Fiscal Pump Printer (EFPP) with respect to all sales that they make and consumers are required to **demand and keep those receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of petroleum product (fuel) and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold do not meet the approved specifications and also, provide an assurance that appropriate government taxes on sales of petroleum products are fully accounted for recovery from the Retailers.
