A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE TARIFF APPLICATION FROM IGUNGA WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (IGUNGA WSSA) FOR YEARS 2020/21 – 2022/23

Tariff Application No. TR-W-19-002

On 6th February 2020, EWURA received Tariff Application from Igunga Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Igunga WSSA) requesting for a multi - year tariff adjustment (2020/21 – 2022/23) for water supply and sanitation services. Tables 1 to 3 below show current and proposed tariffs and fees.

According to Igunga WSSA, the main justification for tariff review application is to generate enough revenue to meet the envisaged increase of operational and maintenance costs due to the completion and introduction of Lake Victoria water project into Igunga WSSA water supply network. The proposed tariff and charges will enable Igunga WSSA to cover operational costs, expand water network to new areas and undertake water-related investments and therefore ensure better services to the customers.

Pursuant to Section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a public hearing meeting on **Thursday**, 26th March 2020 at Sakao Hall in Igunga Town from 10:00hrs. The main objective of the meeting is to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC), Igunga WSSA's customers and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Those who wish to submit written comments on the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs are invited to do so by writing to the Director General using the above-mentioned address at any time by 23rd March 2020.
