**PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE
WEDNESDAY, 1st APRIL 2020**

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes Cap Prices for petroleum products, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday, 1st April 2020**. Hereinafter, kindly take note of the following:

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene imported in the country through **Dar es Salaam port** have decreased compared to prices published on 4th March 2020. For the month of April 2020, retail prices of Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene decreased by TZS 116/litre (equivalent to 5.28%), TZS 165/litre (equivalent to 7.64%), and TZS 193/litre (equivalent to 9.14%), respectively. Similarly, compared to the publication of last month, wholesale prices of Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene decreased by TZS 116.02/litre (equivalent to 5.58%), TZS 164.05/litre (equivalent to 8.09%) and TZS 192.80/litre (equivalent to 9.68%), respectively.
- (b) Likewise, retail and wholesale prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene imported in the country through **Tanga port** have decreased compared to prices published on 4th March 2020. For the month of April 2020, retail prices of Petrol, Diesel and kerosene **in the Northern regions** (Tanga, Kilimanjaro, Arusha and Manyara) have decreased by TZS 86/litre (equivalent to 3.89%), TZS 56/litre (equivalent to 2.65%) and TZS 85/litre (equivalent to 4.09%), respectively. Similarly, compared to the publication of last month, wholesale prices of Petrol, Diesel and kerosene have decreased by TZS 85.39/litre (equivalent to 4.11%), TZS 56.11/litre (equivalent to 2.81%) and TZS 84.39/litre (equivalent to 4.34%), respectively.
- (c) For the month of April 2020, retail and wholesale prices of petroleum products **in the Southern regions (i.e Mtwara, Lindi and Ruvuma)** shall continue to be the same as those that published on 4th March 2020, because there was no new consignment of petroleum products received through Mtwara port in the month of March 2020. Furthermore, *since there is no Kerosene at Mtwara storage terminals, Petrol Station Operators in Mtwara, Lindi and Ruvuma regions are advised to source the product from Dar es Salaam and therefore, the retail prices of Kerosene for those regions is based on the cost of the product received through Dar es Salaam port and bridging cost to the regions.*
- (d) These changes in local prices are mainly attributed to changes in the world oil market prices and BPS premiums as shown in **Table C and Table D**.
- (e) EWURA would like to remind the public that these cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialling ***152*00#** and then following the provided instructions. This service is free of charge and is available in all mobile phone service providers in the country.

- (f) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (**Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166**), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including cap prices. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (g) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that gives them a competitive advantage provided that, such **price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as it is computed using the approved formula, which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 74 published on 7th February 2020.**
- (h) All petrol stations are required to publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are encouraged to purchase from stations that sell products at the most competitive prices and offer better services. **It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations. Failure to adhere to this directive will attract punitive measures from EWURA.**
- (i) Retailers must issue receipts printed from an Electronic Fiscal Pump Printer (EFPP) with respect to all sales that they make. In addition, consumers are required to **demand and keep those receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of petroleum product (fuel) and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold do not meet the approved specifications and provide an assurance that appropriate government taxes on sales of petroleum products are fully accounted for recovery from the Retailers.
