PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY, 3RD JUNE 2020

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes Cap Prices for petroleum products, applicable in Tanzania Mainland effective **Wednesday**, 3rd **June 2020**. Hereinafter, kindly take note of the following:

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices for Petrol and Diesel imported through **Dar es Salaam port** have decreased compared to prices published on 6th May 2020. However, *Kerosene prices* shall continue to be the same as those that were published on 6th May 2020 because there was no new consignment of Kerosene that was received through Dar es Salaam port in the month of May 2020. For the month of June 2020, retail prices of Petrol and Diesel decreased by TZS 348/litre (equivalent to 18.65%) and TZS 300/litre (equivalent to 16.25%) respectively. Similarly, compared to the publication of last month, wholesale prices of Petrol and Diesel decreased by TZS 347.40/litre (equivalent to 19.93%) and TZS 299.05/litre (equivalent to 17.38%) respectively.
- (b) For the month of June 2020, retail and wholesale prices of petroleum products **in the Northern regions** (**Tanga, Kilimanjaro, Arusha and Manyara**) shall continue to be the same as those that were published on 6th May 2020 because there was no new consignment of petroleum products that was received through Tanga port in the month of May 2020.
- (c) For the month of June 2020, retail and wholesale prices of Petrol in the Southern regions (i.e Mtwara, Lindi and Ruvuma) shall continue to be the same as those that were published on 6th May 2020, because there was no new consignment of Petrol received through Mtwara port in the month of May 2020. Retail and wholesale prices for Diesel have decreased compared to the prices published on 6th May 2020. For the month of June 2020, retail and wholesale prices have decreased by TZS 451 (equivalent to 20.68%) and TZS 450.02 (equivalent to 21.89%) respectively. Furthermore, since there is no Kerosene at Mtwara storage terminals, Petrol Station Operators in Mtwara, Lindi and Ruvuma regions are advised to source the product from Dar es Salaam and therefore, the retail prices of Kerosene for those regions is based on the cost of the product received through Dar es Salaam port and bridging cost to the regions.
- (d) These changes in local prices are mainly attributed to changes in the world oil market prices and BPS premiums as shown in **Table C and Table D**.
- (e) EWURA would like to remind the public that these cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialling *152*00# and then following the provided instructions. This service is free of charge and is available in all mobile phone service providers in the country.
- (f) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (**Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166**), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue

- to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including cap prices. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (g) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that gives them a competitive advantage provided that, such price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as it is computed using the approved formula, which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 74 published on 7th February 2020.
- (h) All petrol stations are required to publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are encouraged to purchase from stations that sell products at the most competitive prices and offer better services. It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations. Failure to adhere to this directive will attract punitive measures from EWURA.
- (i) Retailers must issue receipts printed from an Electronic Fiscal Pump Printer (EFPP) with respect to all sales that they make. In addition, consumers are required to **demand and keep those receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of petroleum product (fuel) and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold do not meet the approved specifications and provide an assurance that appropriate government taxes on sales of petroleum products are fully accounted for recovery from the Retailers.
