

Guidelines for Registration into Tanzanian Local Suppliers and Service Providers (LSSP) Database

Requirements for LSSP Registration

Applicants for registration into LSSP database are required to fulfill the following:

1. Duly filled form N-100;
2. Copy of the Certificate of Incorporation or Registration in Tanzania;
3. Copy of Tax Clearance Certificate issued by Tanzania Revenue Authority or its equivalent if incorporated outside Tanzania;
4. Copy of Tax Identification Number (TIN);
5. Copy of Valid Business License(s);
6. Copy of Certificate of Professional Registration such as the Engineers Registration Board, Contractors Registration Board, Tanzania Law Society, Tanzania Insurance Regulatory Authority, Bank of Tanzania or other certifying bodies;
7. Copy of National Social Security Clearance Certificate issued by the National Social Security Fund (NSSF);
8. Banker's Reference Letter/Bank Statement (at least three months);
9. Current shareholding structure **issued by BRELA**;
10. Scope of expertise, services or specialization with regard to the Petroleum Sub-sector, including the technical capacity (personnel, machinery, and equipment or other related infrastructures; and
11. Any other relevant document(s).

NOTE: Registration into LSSP is meant for local suppliers and service providers.

Foreign companies who wish to provide goods and services must form joint ventures with local companies and local companies in those joint ventures must have at least twenty five percent shares or interest.
