**PUBLIC NOTICE ON CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS EFFECTIVE
WEDNESDAY, 5TH JANUARY 2022**

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes Cap Prices for petroleum products, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday, 05th January 2022**. Hereinafter, kindly take note of the following:

- (a) Retail and wholesale prices of Petrol and Diesel imported through **Dar es Salaam port** have decreased compared to prices published on 1st December 2021. For January 2022, the retail prices of petrol and diesel have decreased by TZS 9/Litre (equivalent to 0.35%) and TZS 67/litre (equivalent to 2.80%) respectively. The retail price of kerosene has increased by TZS 99/litre (equivalent to 4.44%). Likewise, compared to the publication of last month, wholesale prices of petrol and diesel have decreased by TZS 8.82/Litre (equivalent to 0.37%), TZS 66.71/litre (equivalent to 2.95%) respectively. The wholesale price of kerosene has increased by TZS 99.04/litre (equivalent to 4.70%).
- (b) For January 2022, retail and wholesale prices of petrol and diesel **in the Northern regions (Tanga, Kilimanjaro, Arusha, and Manyara)** have decreased compared to prices published on 01st December 2021. For January 2022, retail prices of petrol and diesel have decreased by TZS 4/litre (equivalent to 0.17%) and TZS 44/litre (equivalent to 1.80%) respectively. Similarly, compared to the publication of last month, wholesale prices of petrol and diesel have decreased by TZS 4.35/litre (equivalent to 0.18%) and TZS 43.24/litre (equivalent to 1.89%), respectively. *Due to depletion of kerosene at Tanga storage terminal, Petrol Station Operators in the Northern regions are advised to source kerosene from Dar es Salaam. Therefore, the retail prices of kerosene for those regions are based on the cost of the product received through Dar es Salaam port and the transport cost to the respective regions.*
- (c) For January 2022, retail and wholesale prices of petrol for **Southern**

regions (Mtwara, Lindi, and Ruvuma) have decreased while retail and wholesale prices of diesel have increased compared to prices published on 01st December 2021. For January 2022, retail price of petrol has decreased by TZS 35/litre (equivalent to 1.38%) and price of diesel has increased by TZS 2/litre (equivalent to 0.07%). Similarly, compared to the publication of last month, wholesale price of petrol has decreased by TZS 35.25/litre (equivalent to 1.45%) and price of diesel has increased by TZS1.65/litre (equivalent to 0.07%). *Due to unavailability of kerosene at Mtwara storage terminals, Petrol Station Operators in the Southern regions are advised to source kerosene from Dar es Salaam. Therefore, the retail prices of kerosene for those regions are based on the cost of the product received through Dar es Salaam port and the transport cost to the respective regions.*

- (d) Changes in local prices are mainly attributed to changes in the world oil market prices and BPS premiums.
- (e) EWURA would like to remind the public that these cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialing ***152*00#** and then following the provided instructions. This service is free of charge and is available in all mobile phone service providers in the country.
- (f) In line with the prevailing sector legislation (**Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166**), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including cap prices. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders to make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (g) Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that gives them a competitive advantage provided that, such **price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product as it is computed using the approved formula, which was gazetted through the Government Notice No. 2A published on 3rd January 2022.**
- (h) All petrol stations are required to publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are encouraged to purchase from stations that sell products at the most competitive prices and offer better services. **It is an offense not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations. Failure to adhere to this directive will attract punitive measures from EWURA.**

- (i) Retailers must issue receipts printed from an Electronic Fiscal Pump Printer (EFPP) for all sales that they make. In addition, consumers are required to **demand and keep those receipts** that clearly show the name of the petrol station, the date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of petroleum product (fuel) and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold do not meet the approved specifications and provide an assurance that appropriate government taxes on sales of petroleum products are fully accounted for recovery from the Retailers.
