A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON MULTIYEAR TARIFF APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY KARATU WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (KARATU WSSA)

On 28th April 2022 the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) received an application for multiyear tariff adjustment from Karatu Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Karatu WSSA). Tables 1 to 3 below present tariffs and fees proposed by Karatu WSSA.

According to Karatu WSSA, the proposed tariffs and fees will enable the utility to implement operational and investment activities set out in her business plan for the period of 2022/23-2023/24 hence ensure sustainability of water supply and sanitation services in Karatu Town. The tariffs and fees will enhance an increase in water production, extension

of water network to unserved areas, improvement in utility staffing and meeting the rising operational expenses.

Pursuant to Section 19(2) (b) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, there shall be a Public Hearing meeting on **Thursday, 23rd June 2022** at **KDA Hall**, Karatu Town from **10:00hrs**. The main objective of the meeting is to collect views of stakeholders including Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC), Karatu WSSA's customers and the public in general on the reasonableness of the proposed tariff application.

Stakeholders are requested to submit written comments to the Director General through the above-mentioned address at any time by 30th June 2022.
