**A CALL FOR STAKEHOLDERS' VIEWS ON THE MULTIYEAR TARIFF APPLICATION  
 SUBMITTED BY MBULU WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION AUTHORITY (MBULU  
 WSSA)**

On 21<sup>st</sup> July 2022, EWURA received an application from Mbulu Water Supply and Sanitation Authority (Mbulu WSSA) requesting approval of multiyear tariffs and fees applicable to water supply services in financial years 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25. Tables 1 to 3 below present tariffs and fees proposed by Mbulu WSSA.

This public notice is made pursuant to Section 19(4) of the EWURA Act, Cap 414, which requires the Authority to issue a notice of inquiry to collect views from stakeholders including the Government Consultative Council (GCC), Consumer Consultative Council (CCC), Mbulu WSSA's customers and the general public on the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs and fees. As part of an inquiry, there shall be a public inquiry meeting on Thursday, 15<sup>th</sup> September 2022 at Community Centre Hall in Mbulu town from 10:00hrs.
