(O.XXXV, r. 2(1) of the Civil Procedure Code)

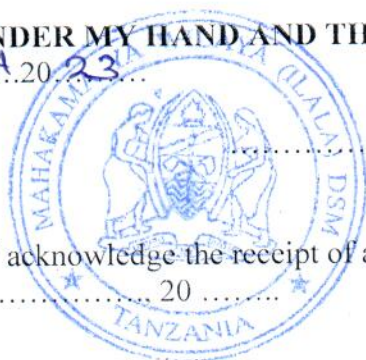
To DELTA PETROLEUM LIMITED

WHEREAS the above named Plaintiff(s) has/have instituted a suit against you under Order XXXV of the Civil Procedure Code Act [Cap. 33 R.E. 2019] for Tshs. 90,800,277.25 being the principal sum and interest due to him as per plaint annexed hereto, you are hereby summoned to obtain leave from the court within twenty one (21) days from the service hereof to appear and defend the suit and within such time to cause an appearance to be entered for you.

In default whereof the plaintiff will be entitled at any time after the expiration of such twenty one days to obtain a decree for any sum not exceeding the sum of T.shs 90,800,277.25 and costs with such interest, if any, from the date of the institution of the suit as the court may order.

Leave to appear and defend may be obtained on an application to the court supported by affidavit or declaration showing that there is a defence to the suit on the merits or that it is reasonable that you should be allowed to appear in the suit.
