## PUBLIC NOTICE

## ORDER TO ALL INDUSTRIES IN TANZANIA

Pursuant to Section 8 (1)(a) of the Electricity Act, Cap 131 and Rule 4(1) of the Electricity (Generation, Transmission, Distribution) Rules, GN. No.287 of 2019, any person generating electricity above one Megawatt (1MW) for own-use is required to apply and obtain a licence from EWURA.

Furthermore, section 8(1)(h) of the Electricity Act, Cap.131, and Rule 4(1) of the Electricity (Electrical installation services) Rules, 2022, requires that any person in Tanzania Mainland carrying out electrical installation works must possess an electrical installation licence issued by EWURA. Contravention of this mandatory requirement amounts to an offence punishable by law.

In that regard, the Energy and Water Utility Regulatory Authority (EWURA) requires all industries in Tanzania Mainland to comply with Law by applying for own-use generation licence for the facility with a capacity above one MegaWatt (1MW) by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2023.
