PUBLIC NOTICE

PETROLEUM PRODUCTS CAP PRICE WITH EFFECT FROM WEDNESDAY, 5TH JULY 2023

The Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) hereby publishes Cap Prices for petroleum products, applicable in Tanzania Mainland. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday**, 5th **July 2023 at 12:01 am**. Hereinafter, kindly take note of the following:

- (a) Retail prices of petrol and diesel imported through Dar es Salaam port have decreased by TZS 137/litre and TZS 118/litre, respectively, compared to the prices that were published on 7th June 2023. Furthermore, the price of kerosene shall remain the same as the price that was published on 7th June 2023 as there was no consignment received in June 2023.
- (b) For Northern regions (Tanga, Kilimanjaro, Arusha, and Manyara), the retail prices of petrol has decreased by TZS 188/litre whilst the price of diesel has increased by TZS 58/litre as compared to the prices that were published on 7th June 2023.
- (c) For the Southern Regions (Lindi, Mtwara and Ruvuma) retail prices for diesel shall remain the same as the prices that were published on 7th June 2023 as there was no consignment of diesel received through Mtwara port. Due to insufficient stock of petrol at Mtwara storage terminals, Petrol Station Operators in the Southern regions are advised to source the product from Dar es Salaam; and therefore prices for petrol for those regions shall base on retail cap price of Dar es Salaam plus the transport costs to

Southern Regions.

(d) Moreover, due to the unavailability of kerosene at Tanga and Mtwara storage terminals, Operators in the Northern and Southern regions are advised to source kerosene from Dar es Salaam; and therefore retail prices of kerosene for those regions shall base on the retail cap price of Dar es Salaam plus the transport costs to the respective regions.

Prices for each region, district and town, are indicated in **Table 1**. Prices differ from one location to another due to differences in prices at the recommended loading ports and transport costs to respective regions, districts and towns.

Changes in local prices are mainly attributed to changes in the world oil market prices, BPS premiums and the value of the Tanzanian Shilling against the US Dollar.

During the implementation of these prices, wholesalers, retailers and the general public are required to adhere to the following: -

- These cap prices can be accessed through mobile phones by dialling
 *152*00# by following the provided instructions. This service is free of charge and is available to all mobile phone service providers in the country.
- ii. In line with the prevailing sector legislation (Petroleum Act, 2015, section 166), prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of demand and supply. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including cap prices. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders to make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- iii. Oil Marketing Companies are free to sell their products at a price that gives them a competitive advantage provided that, such price does not exceed the price cap and is not below the floor price for the relevant product as it is computed according to the EWURA (Petroleum Products Prices Setting) Rules which were gazetted through Government Notice No. 57 published on 28th January 2022 and the EWURA (Petroleum Products Prices Setting)(Amendment) Rules which were gazetted through Government Notice No. 421 published on 23rd June 2023.
- iv. All petrol stations are required to publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered, and any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are encouraged to purchase from stations that sell products at the most competitive prices and offer better services. It is an offence not

- to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations. Failure to adhere to this directive will attract punitive measures from EWURA.
- v. Retailers must issue receipts printed from an Electronic Fiscal Pump Printer (EFPP) for all sales that they make. In addition, consumers are required to demand and keep those receipts that clearly show the name of the petrol station, the date on which such purchase was made as well as, the type of petroleum product (fuel) and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged if the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold do not meet the approved specifications and provide an assurance that appropriate government taxes on sales of petroleum products are fully accounted for recovery from the Retailers.
- vi. Retailers are required to sell petroleum products at prices in Table 1.

 Legal action will be taken against any retailer who fails to comply with these instructions.
- vii. Wholesalers are also required to sell petroleum products at prices indicated in Table 2. Legal action will be taken against any wholesaler who fails to comply with these instructions.
